- (iv) A day prior to the summer vacation, parents teachers meet was organised on 17 May 2018. Parents were apprised about the progress made by their wards in last six months.
- (v) 14 residents were invited to attend a horse show organised at Indian Military Academy on 28 May 2018. The residents were thrilled to witness this programme.
- (vi) Mobile Outreach Programme:
 - (aa) The mobile team visited two blocks of Almora district from 22 to 25 April 2018. An awareness camp was organised where 331 Anganwadis workers participated in the programme.
 - (ab) The mobile outreach team visited in the area of Tehri Garhwal on 14 and 15 May 2018 where the team had identified 15 children for physiotherapy activities. Programme was delivered to the parents to carry out the activities at home.
 - (ac) On 21 May 2018 Raphael's team made a follow-up visit for the children who were identified in the last visit In Bazpur block of Udham Singh Nagar District.
- (v) On 05 April 2018, district games were organised in Dehradun where 14 athletes and two coaches had participated from Raphael. Our athletes won 6 Gold, 4 Silver and 5 Bronze medals in different events.

He did not show much interest in academics and therefore after completion of 5th class his potential in a vocation was explored. He showed liking towards welding activity. Accordingly, our Resource Teacher liaised with a workshop engaged in welding activity who readily accepted to employ him as an apprentice to begin with. Shah Nawaj is now learning welding with a lot of interest. He is being paid Rs 2000/- as remuneration which keeps him happy and motivated and is a financial help to his home. Well done Shah Nawaj! May you grow in this profession and stand on your own feet.
